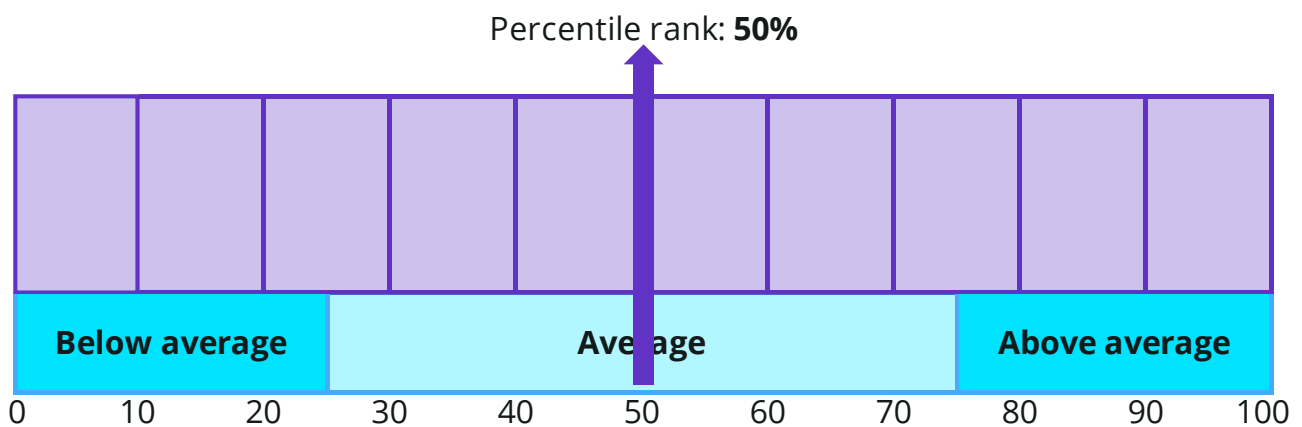

In addition to demonstrating the obtained score, the graph displays a visual representation of the individual's percentile rank. The percentile rank provides an analysis of the individual's performance in relation to the comparison group, thereby allowing meaningful comparisons to be made. For example, a score of 7 equates to a percentile rank of 70%. A percentile rank of 70% indicates that the individual has scored higher than 70% of the comparison group; it does not mean that the individual has scored 70% in the assessment.
